GOD

Who is God? Well I was raised in a church setting from about 8 on, and I have heard all the stories in the Bible and then some. When I was 18 I stood at the back during a sermon. It was a sermon about Jesus, God's Son. It was when Jesus said He knew Abraham. They chased Jesus out, calling him names and threatening his very life. They didn't like Jesus very much, and he was born a Jew, he was one of them. This was Gods People and they didn't know God.

That's when I started to pray. I prayed that God would show me His true religion. I studied, I argued, and I prayed. On one prayer I remembered. Mathew {7:7} Ask, and it shall be given you; seek, and ye shall find; knock, and it shall be opened unto you: {7:8} For every one that asketh receiveth; and he that seeketh findeth; and to him that knocketh it shall be opened. I am 56 now and this is the summery of what I believe God Has showed me.

Chapter 1

In the very beginning there was only God. A thought and nothing more. Nothing was, as nothing had been created. You might call it a void, darkness. Genesis {1:1} In the beginning God created the heaven and the earth. {1:2} And the earth was without form, and void. This void was God himself, and God is infinite in all ways. God knew he was the first and he was self aware, so God tells Moses to introduce him to Pharaoh as and I quote... "Exodus {3:14} And God said unto Moses, I AM THAT I AM: and he said, Thus shalt thou say unto the children of Israel, I AM hath sent me unto you." I AM THAT I AM. The very first thoughts of a conscious being when they realize that they actually exist are "I AM". This is self aware.

God existed before matter, frequencies, or vibrations. God IS. "The eternal God is your dwelling place, and underneath are the everlasting arms. Deuteronomy 33:27". God, has no physical form. God didn't need it to be aware, God was and God had emotions, and reason. Through reason were the first things created, God's family, so God would never be alone again. Eternity was way too long to be alone.

And the evening and the morning were the first day. On the first day the earth was covered in water. God is eternal. This is before man. This is before time.

On the second day. Genesis {1:6} And God said, Let there be a firmament in the midst of the waters, and let it divide the waters from the waters.

{1:7} And God made the firmament, and divided the waters which [were] under the firmament from the waters which [were] above the firmament: and it was so. {1:8} And God called the firmament Heaven. And the evening and the morning were the second day. At the

end of the second day there is still no land. Only water in the skies to start and none there at the end.

On the Third day Genesis {1:9} And God said, Let the waters under the heaven be gathered together unto one place, and let the dry [land] appear: (Earth didn't get land for 4.5 billion years. That land came at one time in one place, one time, Pangea, and that was roughly 350-390 million years ago. Pangea is the fitting together of all the lands of the planet together like a puzzle and that goes all the way to a ball, and I believe it was a moon) and it was so. {1:10} And God called the dry [land] Earth; and the gathering together of the waters called he Seas: and God saw that [it was] good. {1:11} And God said, Let the earth bring forth grass, the herb yielding seed, [and] the fruit tree yielding fruit after his kind, whose seed [is] in itself, upon the earth: and it was so. {1:12} And the earth brought forth grass, [and] herb yielding seed after his kind, and the tree yielding fruit, whose seed [was] in itself, after his kind: and God saw that [it was] good. {1:13} And the evening and the morning were the third day.

On the fourth day. Genesis {1:14} And God said, Let there be lights in the firmament of the heaven to divide the day from the night; and let them be for signs, and for seasons, and for days, and years: {1:15} And let them be for lights in the firmament of the heaven to give light upon the earth: and it was so. {1:16} And God made two great lights; the greater light to rule the day, and the lesser light to rule the night: [he made] the stars also. (God had to work on the sky because the old moon was now land in the midst of water, and now God needed a new moon) {1:17} And God set them in the firmament of the heaven to give light upon the earth, {1:18} And to rule over the day and over the night, and to divide the light from the darkness: and God saw that [it was] good.

{1:19} And the evening and the morning were the fourth day.

On the fifth day. Genesis {1:20} And God said, Let the waters bring forth abundantly the moving creature that hath life, and fowl [that] may fly above the earth in the open firmament of heaven. {1:21} And God created great whales, and every living creature that moveth, which the waters brought forth abundantly, after their kind, and every winged fowl after his kind: and God saw that [it was] good. (First came the plants, plant eaters and then to keep the balance came the carnivores. Like any habitat you must first have a thriving and sustaining ecosystem.) {1:22} And God blessed them, saying, Be fruitful, and multiply, and fill the waters in the seas, and let fowl multiply in the earth. {1:23} And the evening and the morning were the fifth day.

On the sixth day. Genesis {1:24} And God said, Let the earth bring forth the living creature after his kind, cattle, and creeping thing, and beast of the earth after his kind: and it was so. {1:25} And God made the beast of the earth after his kind, and cattle after their kind, and every thing that creepeth upon the earth after his kind: and God saw that [it was] good. {1:26} And God said, Let us make man in our image, after our likeness: (God has no form, and as such has no body, man got Gods ability to reason) and let them have dominion over the fish of the sea, and over the fowl of the air, and over the cattle, and over all the earth, and over every creeping thing that creepeth upon the earth.

{1:27} So God created man in his [own] image, in the image of God created he him; male and female created he them. (The oldest fossils of mankind is only 200000 years old) {1:28} And God blessed them, and God said unto them, Be fruitful, and multiply, and replenish the earth, and subdue it: and have dominion over the fish of the sea, and over the fowl of the air, and over every living thing that moveth upon the earth. {1:29} And God said, Behold, I have given you every herb bearing seed, which [is] upon the face of all the earth, and every tree, in the which [is] the fruit of a tree yielding seed; to you it shall be for meat. {1:30} And to every beast of the earth, and to every fowl of the air, and to every thing that

creepeth upon the earth, wherein [there is] life, [I have given] every green herb for meat: and it was so. {1:31} And God saw every thing that he had made, and, behold, [it was] very good. And the evening and the morning were the sixth day.

On the seventh day. Genesis {2:1} Thus the heavens and the earth were finished, and all the host of them. {2:2} And on the seventh day God ended his work which he had made; and he rested on the seventh day from all his work which he had made. {2:3} And God blessed the seventh day, and sanctified it: because that in it he had rested from all his work which God created and made.

{2:4} These [are] the generations of the heavens and of the earth when they were created, in the day that the LORD God made the earth and the heavens, {2:5} And every plant of the field before it was in the earth, and every herb of the field before it grew: for the LORD God had not caused it to rain upon the earth, and [there was] not a man to till the ground. {2:6} But there went up a mist from the earth, and watered the whole face of the ground. {2:7} And the LORD God formed man [of] the dust of the ground, and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life; and man became a living soul.

Chapter 2

God always was, and his works were of Intelligent and reasonable design. How then do explain the evolution of creatures one to another. Plain and simple, God reasons. These creations of his are Proof of God living forever. God imagined. These were new to even God, and God was having fun with creation, improving them. Making Improvements that benefitted the world according to it's need and purpose. Remember that God made you and this world, is not for you to own but to dress it and keep it. It belongs to God not us. Genesis {2:15} And the LORD God took the man, and put him into the garden of Eden to dress it and to keep it.

2 {20:4} Thou shalt not make unto thee any graven image, or any likeness [of any thing] that [is] in heaven above, or that [is] in the earth beneath, or that [is] in the water under the earth: {20:5} Thou shalt not bow down thyself to them, nor serve them: for I the LORD thy God [am] a jealous God, visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children unto the third and fourth [generation] of them that hate me; {20:6} And shewing mercy unto thousands of them that love me, and keep my commandments.

 $\mathbf{3}_{\{20:7\}}$ Thou shalt not take the name of the LORD thy God in vain; for the LORD will not hold him guiltless that taketh his name in vain.

4_{20:8} Remember the sabbath day, to keep it holy. {20:9} Six days shalt thou labour, and do all thy work: {20:10} But the seventh day [is] the sabbath of the LORD thy God: [in it] thou shalt not do any work, thou, nor thy son, nor thy daughter, thy manservant, nor thy maidservant, nor thy cattle, nor thy stranger that [is] within thy gates: {20:11} For [in] six days the LORD made heaven and earth, the sea, and all that in them [is,] and rested the seventh day: wherefore the LORD blessed the sabbath day, and hallowed it. God didn't say go to Church. God wants you to remember Creation and the greatness of God. It also says to take at least one day off from work a week, and in order to have a day off you must also work. God blesses action as only in action is there anything to bless. Have fun and remember that God is in all life, so commune.

5 {20:12} Honour thy father and thy mother: that thy days may be long upon the land which the LORD thy God giveth thee.

6 {20:13} Thou shalt not kill.

7 {20:14} Thou shalt not commit adultery.

8 {20:15} Thou shalt not steal.

9 {20:16} Thou shalt not bear false witness against thy neighbour.

 $10_{\{20:17\}}$ Thou shalt not covet thy neighbour's house, thou shalt not covet thy neighbour's wife, nor his manservant, nor his maidservant, nor his ox, nor his ass, nor any thing that [is] thy neighbour's.

These are God's laws, none religious in nature, and meant to ready man to coexist with God and others. As creation took billions of years other civilizations would be necessary to get Man just right, Gods Crowning Jewels. Just as God created the sea, the earth and the Heavens, God created man, all that God Created will be renewed without sin after God comes to meat us in person.

God Created vessels of all types for Him to inhabit, and God wants to enjoy the life given you as much as you. God is life, all life is God. God is in the grass, the trees and all else, and the self you have could have just as easily been a sparrow or a mustard seed.
